

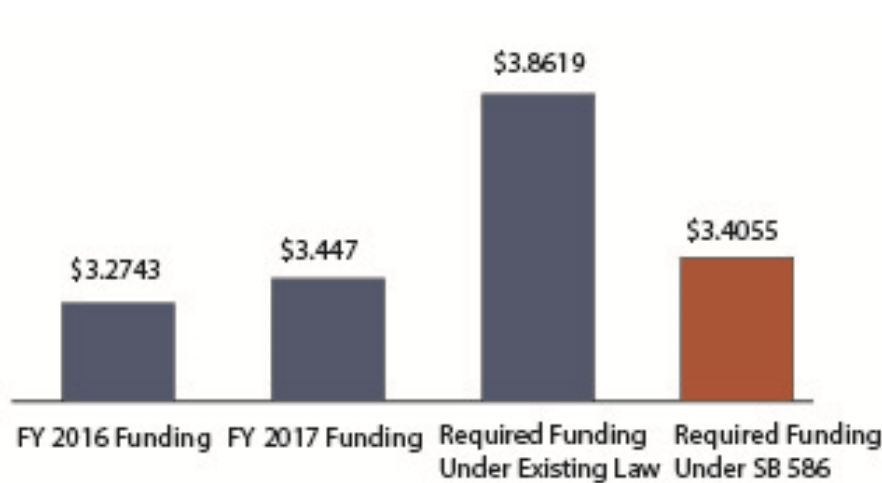

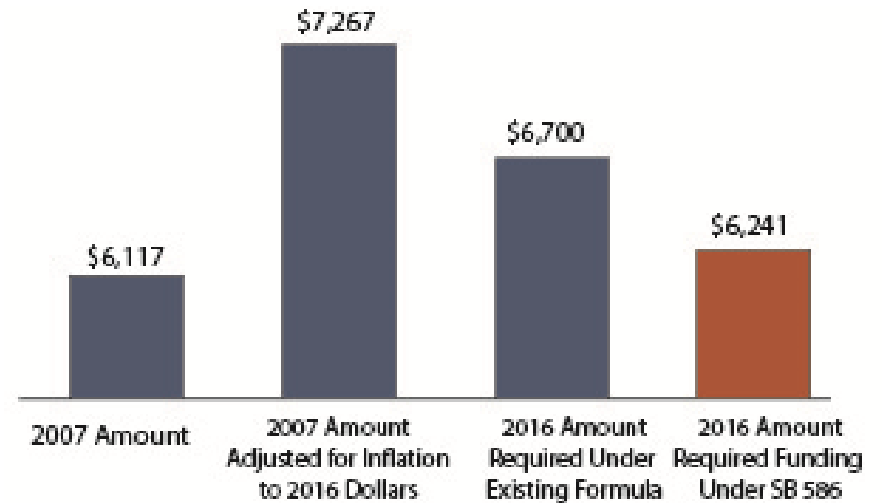

After Reinstatement of Cap***

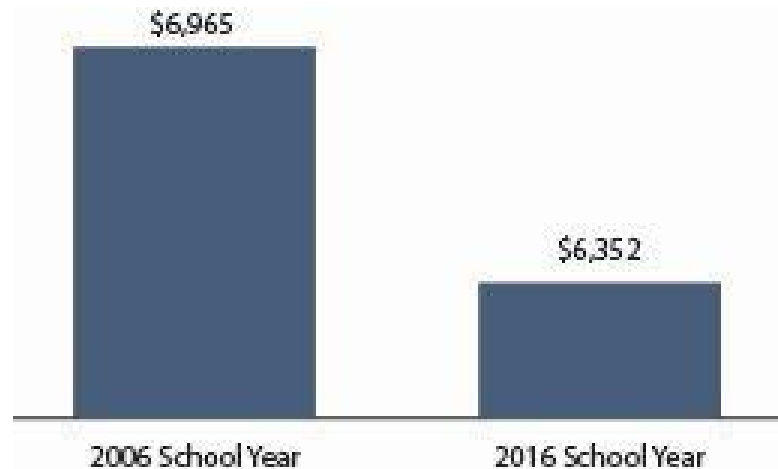


***Required Per Student Funding

Adjusted For Inflation***



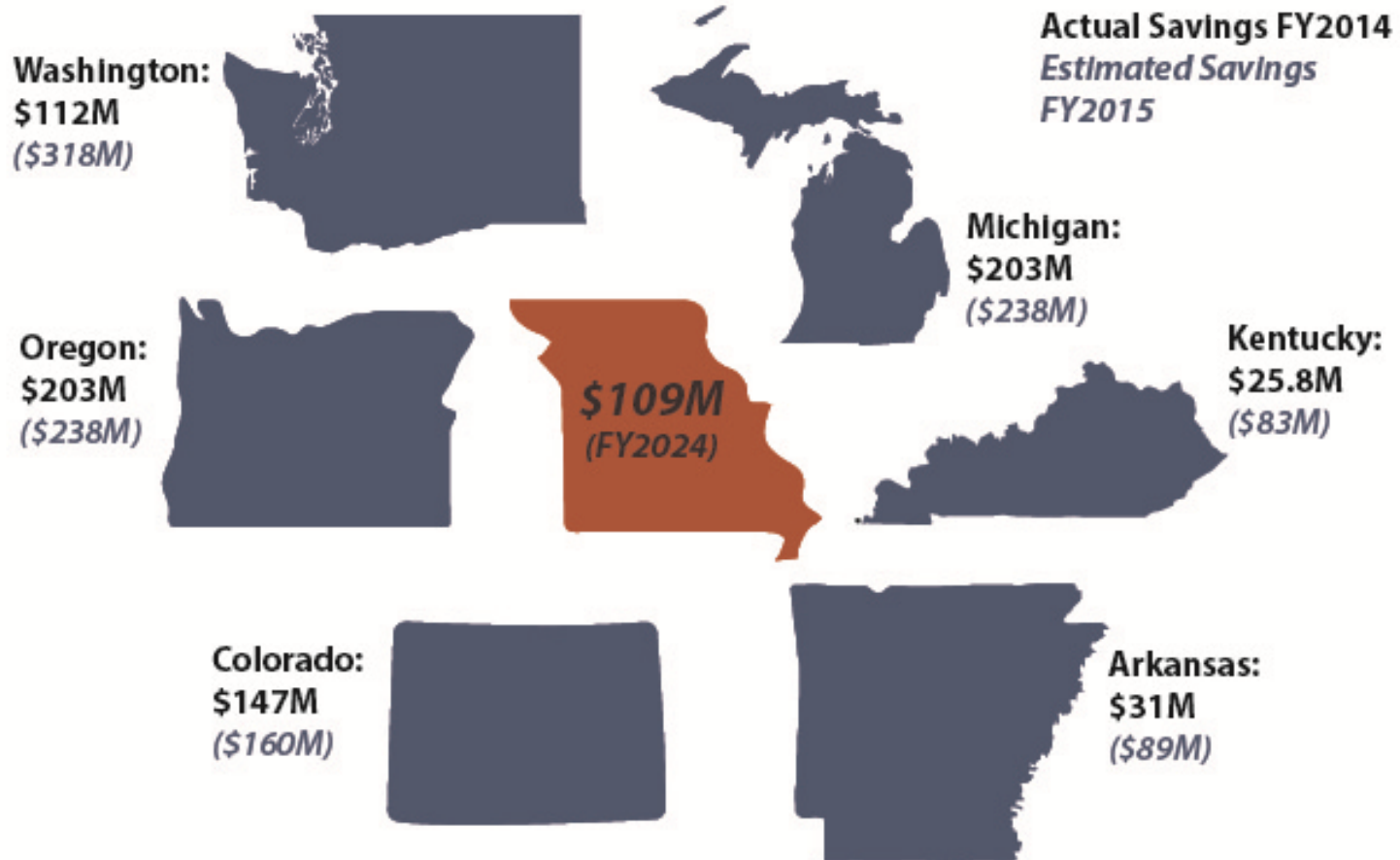
## ***Higher Education Funding Increased, Remains Far Below 2007 Level***
